

COVID-19 UPDATE: SAFETY PRECAUTIONS & PROTOCOLS

While we have been grateful to be able to stay open amid the current public health conditions, it is only with the utmost care. In addition to all normal safety and cleanliness procedures related to operating a medical practice, we've implemented several additional measures:

- Consultations and intakes performed on phone.
- Printable paperwork available online.
- Verbally screening patients, including immediate contacts, for any recent respiratory symptoms or travel.
- Taking patients' temperature upon arrival with no-touch infrared forehead thermometer, denying service anyone at or above 100.4 F and following up immediately with instructions by phone.
- Whenever possible, transactions processed on phone or otherwise without handling cards.
- Whenever possible, extra time scheduled between patients with two separate rooms for further distancing.
- High-risk patients handled specially case-by-case to ensure further distancing measures.
- Facemasks worn by practitioner and patient upon arrival through departure.
- Facemask worn by practitioner when on phone or otherwise speaking at length in clinic.
- Hand washing/sanitizing protocols and coughing/sneezing etiquette visibly posted at clinic entrance and in lobby.
- Hand sanitizer available onsite for patients.
- Table paper covering entire surfaces.
- Removing all unnecessary objects from common areas.
- Clinic-dedicated attire.
- Practitioner self-monitoring temperature twice daily.
- Dedicated mail and delivery handling protocols.
- Located in professional building where neighbors also have low-volume traffic.
- All other CDC recommendations as they develop.
